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1. Introduction

These Terms of Use govern your access to and use of the Ozeon website at <https://ozeon.com>, including related pages, forms, early access signups, waitlist features, website content, and restricted internal or editor functionality that Ozeon may make available.

By accessing or using the website, you agree to these Terms of Use. If you do not agree, you should not use the website.

These Terms apply to the current Ozeon public website. They do not yet fully govern future public platform features such as user accounts, organisation accounts, payments, project publishing, project funding, subscriptions, article/media/tutorial publishing, bounties, DAO participation, Educational Resources, Progress tokens, \$OZN utility, NFTs, IP-NFTs, OCIS climate intelligence, dMRV monitoring and reports, AI Footprint, project verification workflows, or public platform file and media uploads. Before those features launch publicly, Ozeon may publish additional terms — platform rules, contributor terms, publication terms, payment terms, funding terms, governance terms, token terms, risk notices, verification terms, OCIS terms, dMRV terms, or other service-specific agreements.

2. Who We Are

Unless otherwise stated, "Ozeon," "we," "us," or "our" in these Terms means Ozeon OÜ in relation to the current website. "You" means the person or organisation accessing or using the website.

3. What Ozeon Is

Ozeon is a regenerative innovation platform being developed to connect knowledge, learning, publishing, projects, organisations, Open Calls, funding, governance, and verification across ocean, climate, land, and sustainability-related work.

The current website provides information about Ozeon, its mission, platform roadmap, current and planned features, early access opportunities, educational content, project information, organisation information, and related communications. Some features described may be planned, in development, experimental, in beta, restricted to internal testing, or subject to future launch conditions.

4. Eligibility

You may use the website if you are legally able to enter into these Terms under the laws that apply to you. The current website is not intentionally directed at children under the age required by applicable law for independent consent. If you use the website on behalf of an organisation, you confirm that you have authority to do so and to bind that organisation where applicable.

5. Acceptable Use

You may use the website for lawful, personal, informational, educational, professional, partnership, or early access purposes. You agree **not** to:

Legal and content standards

- use the website for unlawful, fraudulent, abusive, harmful, or misleading purposes
- submit content that is false, deceptive, defamatory, threatening, hateful, harassing, obscene, discriminatory, exploitative, or infringing
- submit content that violates intellectual property, privacy, confidentiality, cultural, community, or Indigenous knowledge rights (see Section 20)

Security and technical integrity

- attempt to gain unauthorised access to systems, accounts, databases, source code, infrastructure, or restricted/admin areas
- introduce malware, viruses, spyware, ransomware, or other malicious or harmful code
- scrape, crawl, harvest, or extract data without permission
- interfere with rate limits, abuse-prevention systems, authentication, consent controls, or other security measures
- use automated systems — bots, spam tools, or similar — in a way that burdens, disrupts, or abuses the website

Identity and representation

- misrepresent your identity, role, organisation, affiliation, or authority
- impersonate any person, organisation, partner, funder, public authority, or Ozeon representative
- imply false endorsement, partnership, accreditation, investment status, verification, or approval

Ozeon's rights and brand

- use Ozeon's name, trademarks, brand, or content in a misleading or unauthorised way (see Section 13)
- use the website to send spam or unauthorised communications
- otherwise violate applicable laws, regulations, third-party rights, or these Terms

Ozeon may restrict, suspend, or remove access to address a breach of this section — see Section 21 (Suspension, Restriction, and Removal).

6. Early Access, Waitlist, and Signup Forms

The website may allow users to join an early access list, waitlist, newsletter, or related platform interest form. Submitting a form does not guarantee access to the platform, acceptance into any programme, partnership, funding opportunity, beta test, feature, or future service.

Ozeon may use signup information to understand user interest, organise onboarding, send relevant updates, manage communications, and develop the platform. Information you submit through forms must be accurate, and must not be false, misleading, unlawful, abusive, or submitted on behalf of another person without authority.

7. Communications

By submitting a form, joining the waitlist, contacting Ozeon, or requesting information, you agree that Ozeon may contact you in relation to your request. Ozeon may send confirmation emails, verification emails, early access updates, launch updates, partnership responses, onboarding information, service-related communications, and other communications you request or consent to receive.

Transactional or service-related messages may still be sent where necessary to provide a requested service, confirm an action, or protect account security.

8. Restricted Studio, Editor, and Administrative Access

Ozeon may remove, reject, moderate, edit, or decline to publish submitted content where necessary to protect the website, comply with law, maintain quality standards, or protect users, partners, communities, or third-party rights.

10. Licence to User Submissions

You retain ownership of any rights you hold in content you submit to Ozeon.
